OUT TAKES Dallas And Sundance Channel To Bring "Revolution" to Dallas

Due to special arrangement with Sundance Channel, OUT TAKES Dallas announces that its screening of Margaret Cho's "Revolution" with Sundance Channel will now be provided at NO CHARGE. Previously, tickets were going to be \$5.00. They will be available on a "first-come, first-served" basis at the box office the night of the screening (NOTE - they will no longer be available prior to that date or on the Magnolia Web site).

OUT TAKES Dallas (www.outtakesdallas.org), with Sundance Channel will host the Dallas Premiere presentation of Margaret Cho's tour concert film, "Revolution," as a One Night Engagement on Tuesday, June 15.

"Revolution", Margaret Cho's 3rd sold-out national tour, was heralded by the Chicago Sun-Times as "Her strongest show yet!" In "Revolution", Cho returns to the screen with the same unbridled, no holds-barred humor that infused her previous films. With her signature style, Margaret tackles the axis of evil, her travels through Thailand's red light district, the explosion of child birth, bartering sex for household chores, Revolutionizing one's self-esteem, the joy of bodily functions, her loser ex-boyfriend, and of course, her now world-famous mother.

To explain the tour's name, Cho said, "I named it 'Revolution' because we really need one right now. Plus, I think that Prince's backup band before the New Power Generation gets routinely ignored."

Filmed live at the Wiltern Theater in Los Angeles, California in 2003, "Revolution" was written by and stars Margaret Cho and Bruce Daniels. The film was directed, produced and edited by Lorene Machado. Margaret Cho and Karen Taussig are the executive producers. "Revolution" is a Cho Taussig Production.

Sundance Channel is bringing Margaret Cho's "Revolution" to Dallas for this event as a part of its sponsorship of OUT TAKES Dallas.
